CART Youth is a race team, not a ski school. Skiers must be skiing Intermediate (Blue) terrain with linked parallel turns. Our training does not allow us to admit skiers making wedge/snowplow turns. The objective is to **Enjoy the Journey**, build fundamental skills, movements and race course tactics. Our Coaches maintain PSIA level III and/or USSA Level 200 certifications. They will develop a personal plan for each athlete and use this as a reference for individual improvement. Practice courses are employed in a safe, and supportive environment. We offer the opportunity to experience racing at your pace, commitment of time, travel and budget.
